UBCCE – ATAMEKEN - KAZENERGY: “Development of the Black Sea and Caspian largely depends on cooperation among business organizations of the Region”

Union of Black Sea and Caspian Confederation of Enterprises (UBCCE), the first independent and voluntary business organization of the Black Sea and Caspian Region and its Kazakh members, National Economic Chamber of Kazakhstan (Atameken) and Kazakhstan Association of Oil-Gas and Energy Sector Organizations (KazEnergy), using the occasion of the 3rd Eurasian Energy Forum organized by KazEnergy in Astana, Kazakhstan, underlines once more the importance attached to the development of cooperation among business organizations for the common welfare of the Region.

Kazakhstan is one of the founder countries of UBCCE and runs currently one of the Vice Presidencies of the Union. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to be signed between UBCCE and its Kazakh members aiming to further deepen the cooperation among the parties.
